We were very glad to see our students after Christmas break and happy to know that all of them had a safe holiday and a Happy New Year of 2017.

The first semester of school year 2016 - 2017 passed. Students have gained useful knowledge and experience through fun and excited activities. The results of teaching festival and SA1 exams reflect the effort of our teachers and students. Our students have worked very hard for the exams and achieved commendable results: 100% students got Good and above for Math, Satisfactory and above for Vietnamese and no students failed to meet requirements. We highly appreciate the efforts of students as well as the teachers. Besides learning activities at school, students eagerly participated in other activities for primary students. 34 students (Year 3,4,5) took the online English Olympic contest with 1200 point and above and 26 students among them passed 20th round to participate in district level contest.
