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Dear Parents,

February and March were the months that we put into motion a lot of useful and interesting teaching techniques and learning activities for teachers and students in the Integrated Program. Teachers put lots of effort in teaching to build quality lessons and innovative teaching methods to provide better learning outcomes for students. I was very impressed to see good progress in Year 1 and Year 2 students in learning and practicing what they have learnt. It is the result of the teachers and students' combined effort and the strong support from parents.

Year 1 has made great progress in handwriting and they can read quite proficiently, with some students having already read expressive texts.
