For Grades 5 and 6, we will be focusing on test preparation for the IPLSE and ISA test components, ensuring our students are well-prepared and confident. Grade 4 will continue to develop their language abilities in the class with their regular class teachers.

This shift allows for more targeted teaching, consistent monitoring, and the opportunity to directly address the skills needed for both our school assessments and international testing standards.
