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The children were ecstatic and intrigued, especially with the robots that can be part of learning and play! During the activity, the students were supervised and guided by the Teacher and Teaching Assistant. They learned how to make the robots move using a controller pen and complete some simple commands via code. They also enjoyed making images using the Teachable Machine Apps.
