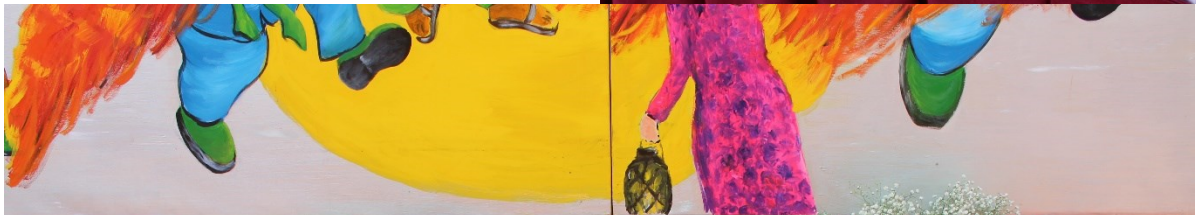
















## Student Council
