
As we move forward into another exciting term, we are pleased to share some recent highlights and upcoming activities in our school community.

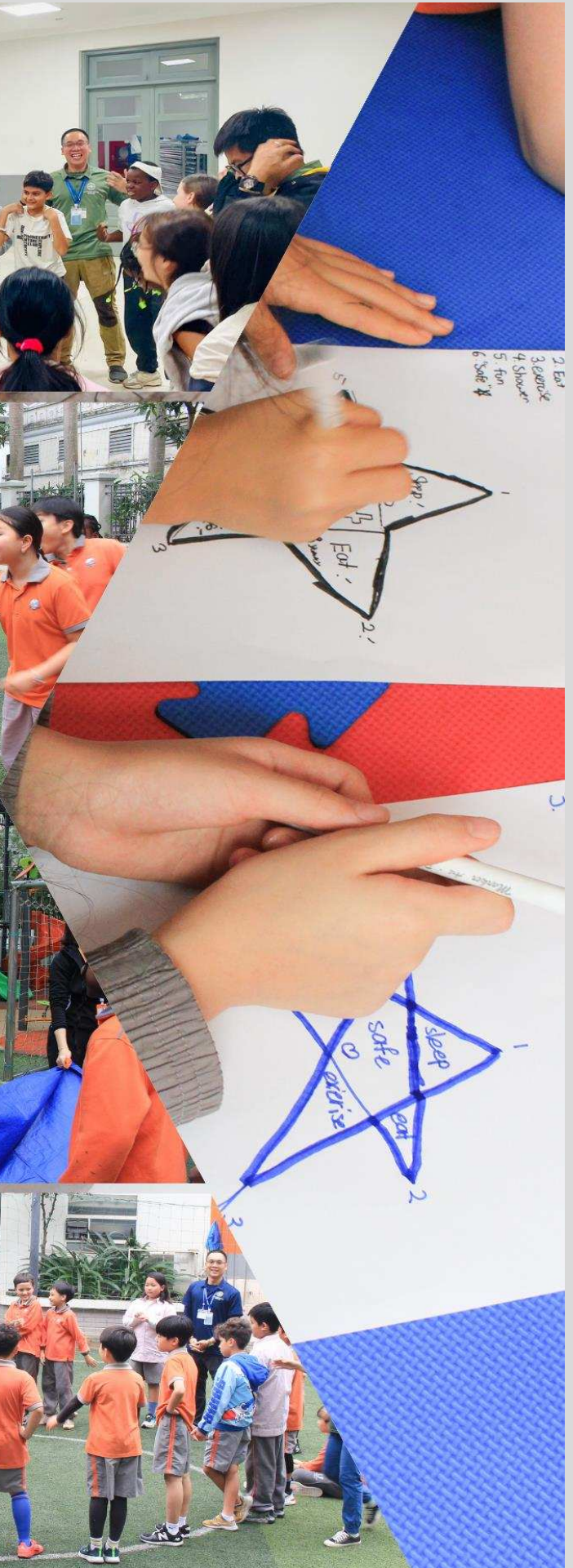
Outward-Bound Vietnam (OBV) – Year 4 & 5 Adventure

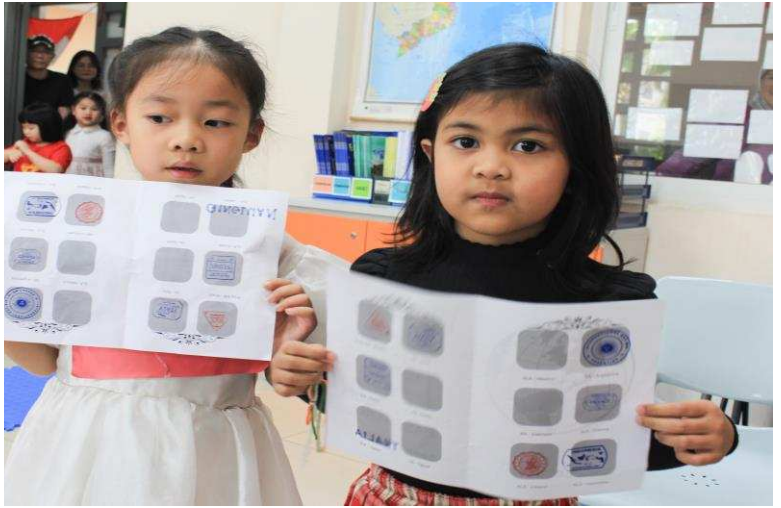












Academic Achievement – C1 English Certification
